REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

November 2, 1981

The Commerce Board of Education met in regular session November 2, 1981 at 6:30 P.M. in the high school teachers lounge.

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 P.M. by Vice President Gerald Moudy. The following members were present: Moudy, Gilbert, Hulsey, Price.

Invocation: The invocation was given by Mrs. Carol Olds.

Ralph Cook arrived and assumed his duties as president of the board.

Visiting participants were recognized.

Motion: The minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motion by Gene Hulsey and seconded by Tom Gilbert that the minutes be approved as read. Votes: Yes - Hulsey, Gilbert, Price, Moudy, Cook; no votes - 0.

Motion: The treasurer's report was reviewed. Motion by Price and second by Gilbert that the report be approved as presented. Votes: yes - Price, Gilbert, Cook, Hulsey, Moudy. No votes - 0.

Motion by Moudy and second by Hulsey that the bills be approved as listed and warrants drawn for same. Vote: Yes - Moudy, Hulsey, Cook, Price, Gilbert. No votes - 0.

Motion: The constitution of the National Honor Society was reviewed and discussed at length after which a motion was made by Cook and seconded by Price that Commerce Schools adopt the constitution of the National Honor Society as so stated in their constitution. Yes votes: Cook, Price, Moudy, Hulsey. No votes: Gilbert. Motion carried.

Motion by Hulsey and second by Moudy that the policies of the Board of Education presented at last meeting be approved as stated. Votes: Yes - Hulsey, Moudy, Cook, Gilbert, Price. No votes - 0.

The lunch report was presented by Rosie Hines, Food Service Director. Motion by Hulsey and second by Price that the lunch report be approved. Votes: yes - Hulsey, Price, Moudy, Cook, Gilbert. No votes - 0.

John Duncan was present and track data presented and discussed. The Board will have a Special Meeting November 17, 1981 at 7:00 for in depth discussion of track.

Motion: Motion by Moudy and second by Hulsey to convene into executive session for employment hearing of Earl Rogers and other personnel request at 9:00.
