

**OUT OF SCHOOL SUSPENSION OF STUDENTS FOR NON-VIOLENT OFFENSES**

It is the policy of the Commerce Public Schools Board of Education that a student suspended out of school for a non-violent offense shall be placed in a supervised structured environment in either a home-based school work assignment setting or another appropriate setting in accordance with a plan prescribed by the school administration that provides education to and monitoring of the student, which shall be complied with by the parent or guardian. The suspension shall not extend beyond the current school semester and the succeeding semester.
